NS envisages working with other like-minded groups on the issues of Human trafficking focusing on Assisted Rescue, Rehabilitation and Returned Reintegration based on the needs and aspiration of the individual person.

Our vision is to create a safe, supportive and responsive society that upholds the protection dignity of every Human being. NS has a long-term view of preventing human trafficking and modern day slavery, manifested as forced prostitution and second-generation prostitution in the context of Ethiopia.

The **Mission** as a non-governmental organisation is to promote the dignity of persons. The services are designed to provide safety and opportunities for healing, growth, and self-determination by availing resources through rehabilitation and reintegration.

We have experience in receiving volunteer returnees from the Netherlands and Germany and assisting in their resettlement back in Ethiopia.

Who is ETTC?

ETTC (European Technology and Training Centre) organizes activities aimed at the professional development of employees in the public sector. It also has solid experience in the fields of return and reintegration. ETTC has a main office and training center in Erbil, sub office in Suleimaniyah and focal points in Duhok, Kirkuk and Baghdad.* ETTC's chain of services with the individual clients starts with pick-up at the airport and ends with monitoring visits at their place of work up to a year after returning. In between there are numbers of activities focusing on social integration and getting into a sustainable job placement.

Who is Idia Renaissance?

Idia Renaissance organises activities aimed at education and the empowerment of different groups, amongst them Nigerians returning from Europe and victims of human trafficking. Idia Renaissance has its headquarters and training centre in Benin City and a branch office in Lagos. It has access to a nation-wide network of organisations that can offer additional support.

What kind of assistance does Idia renaissance offer to returnees?

- Reception at the airport.
- Temporary housing upon arrival.
- Individual guidance.
- Support with establishing a small-scale business or finding a job.
- Support with finding a suitable educational track or (vocational) training.
- Referral to healthcare institutions.
- Referral to specialised support for victims of human trafficking.
- Support in finding the right contacts.
- Mediation in restoring contact with family members.
- Administrative support.
- Provide information about the country.

In consultation with Idia Renaissance, you can use the grant of **1.500 euros** per adult and **2.500 euros** per child for matters that advance your reintegration, such as:

- Education or a (vocational) training.
- Starting up a small-scale business.
- Housing.
- Medical care.

Remarks

Idia Renaissance deems it important that people – especially those who have fallen victim to human trafficking – contact the organisation prior to their return, so that they are able to properly prepare their supporting role.
